After a destructive earthquake, emergency diagnostics have to be done on the damaged buildings just a few hours and days after the disastrous event.

TO BE A VOLUNTARY INSPECTOR FOR POST-EARTHQUAKE DISASTER PROCEDURES IN FRANCE

The national emergency procedures :

- > Recognized by the home ministry.
- > Supported by AFPS.
- > Realisation of emergency diagnostics to assess the immediate risk for people.
- > Expertise for the authorities.
- > A national method and a dedicated organisation.
- > Voluntary workers – trained and certified inspectors.

Two fields of intervention :

- > Before crisis : contribution of return of experience (REX), planned, communication and sensibilisation.
- > During the crisis : management of the diagnostic procedures for the authorities.

Intervention area :

France
(international missions are possible)

Volunteer workers of emergency procedures :

- > Unpaid, members of AFPS or not, French or Foreigners.
- > Bringing in help for the emergency procedures : diagnostics, logistic, headquarters.
- > 5 days certificate training is free to become an emergency inspector.
- > CPF and mecenat to facilitate your participation.
- > Need of at least 200 certified inspectors in Antilles and 300 in the Metropole.
